F.1.1 Term of the Contract Extension

F.1.1.1 The term of the contract is extended for the period October 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008.

F.1.2 Option to Extend the Term of the Contract

The District may extend the term of the Contract for a period of one (1) six (6) month Option Period, or successive fractions thereof, by written notice to Contractor before the expiration of the Contract; provided that the District shall give Contractor preliminary written notice of its intent to extend at least thirty (30) days before the Contract expires. The preliminary notice does not commit the District to an extension. The exercise of this option is subject to the availability of funds at the time of the exercise of this option. Contractor may waive the thirty (30) day preliminary notice requirement by providing a written waiver to the Contracting Officer prior to expiration of the Contract.

F.1.2.1 If the District exercises the option described in Section F.1.2, the extended Contract shall be considered to include this option provision.
